Overview

Who owns the electricity supply industry in Zimbabwe?

The electricity supply industry (ESI) is dominated by government owned utility, namely Zimbabwe Electricity Supply Authority (ZESA) Holdings with its subsidiaries: Zimbabwe Power Company (ZPC) and Zimbabwe Electricity Transmission & Distribution Company (ZETDC).

What is Zimbabwe's Electricity generation capacity?

As of 2023, Zimbabwe's installed electricity generation capacity was approximately 2,540 MW. However, due to a combination of factors such as climate change, ageing infrastructure and equipment breakdowns, actual electricity generation is often much lower than this capacity, resulting in power cuts and load shedding.

How is Zimbabwe addressing the electricity shortage?

To address the electricity shortage, the Zimbabwean government has been investing in renewable energy sources such as solar power and also looking into importing electricity from neighboring countries.

Will Zimbabwe end power shortages and load shedding by 2030?

The Zimbabwe Electricity Supply Authority (ZESA) has unveiled ambitious plans to end the country's power shortages and load shedding by 2030. With projects generating 3,000MW currently underway, ZESA says it aims to provide universal access to electricity and eliminate load shedding altogether.

Why is Zimbabwe's Electricity production so low?

It revealed the significant challenges faced by the Zimbabwe Power Company (ZPC), which have led to critically low levels of electricity production. Currently, Zimbabwe's main power sources are operating far below their capacity.



Why is Zimbabwe still facing serious power outages?

"However, in as much as the transmission and distribution lines are functioning well, ZESA management highlighted that Zimbabwe is still facing serious power outages because the distribution supply of electricity is not meeting the nations demand.
