

How much does a shipping container home cost?

Shipping Container homes offer flexibility in cost, ranging from \$25,000 - \$35,000 for a basic 20ft DIY build to prices rivaling traditional construction for luxury builds. Your final cost will largely depend on two factors: whether you manage the project yourself and your choice between basic or premium finishes.

Do shipping container homes cost more than traditional houses?

Shipping container homes cost less than traditional houses. The materials are already on site, and the structure is pre-fabricated. The cost savings can be significant—if you opt for a small house with few amenities or shipping container homes that don't need extra plumbing or wiring. Shipping container homes also need less labor.

How much does a prefab container home cost?

Prefab container homes offer a more affordable option, with costs between \$150 and \$300 per square foot. These homes come with a finished interior and exterior, including fixtures and appliances, and are made at a factory. They require assembly on-site, particularly for homes constructed from multiple containers.

How much does it cost to build a container home?

Cedar siding can transform the industrial look of your container home. For DIY projects, expect to spend around \$1,400 for a 20ft container and \$2,800 for a 40ft container, including materials and labor. Windows range from \$1,200 for a 20ft container to \$2,000 for a 40ft container, while entry doors with hardware can cost up to \$2,000 per door.

How much does a shipping container foundation cost?

There are three popular types of foundations for a shipping container. They're



slab, trench, and concrete pier. The average cost of these three types of foundations ranges from \$4 to \$25 per square foot. The cost of laying a foundation depends on the concrete's thickness and the cost of hiring an expert.

Shipping containers have been used for decades to transport goods by road, railway, or ship. Today, their use has advanced to the creation of houses. 


