

Overview

What is the power source in Zimbabwe?

The power source in Zimbabwe is sourced from local generation and imports. Local generation comes from Kariba Hydropower, Hwange coal-fi red power Station, and three small thermal power plants. Domestic generation comes from Kariba Hydropower, Hwange coal-fi red power Station, and three small thermal power plants. Supplementary power is imported from Mozambique, Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), and Zambia.

Who owns the electricity supply industry in Zimbabwe?

The electricity supply industry (ESI) in Zimbabwe is dominated by government owned power entities. The main entities are the Zimbabwe Power Company (ZPC) and the Zimbabwe Electricity Transmission and Distribution Company (ZETDC).

What are the energy supply options in Zimbabwe?

The energy supply options fro Zimbabwe have a mixture of hydroelectricity, coal and renewable sources. The grid is well developed with efforts after 1980 having extended supplies to rural business and government administrative areas .

Why does Zimbabwe import electricity from Zambia and Mozambique?

Zimbabwe currently imports electricity from Zambia and Mozambique to address the local production shortage. Zimbabwe's ongoing power crisis, growing demand for solar power, and an ideal climate for solar power generation represent a great opportunity for U.S. companies.

How much electricity does Zimbabwe produce?

About 50% of Zimbabwe's electricity demand is driven by the mining and other heavy industries. Despite having a vast renewable energy potential, 18 IPPs produce just about 136 MW of power for own consumption or for trading,



out of which 36 MW is generated from Renewable sources.
