Solar power station in China in Laos





Overview

Construction has commenced on the first phase of the one-million-kilowatt photovoltaic project at China General Nuclear Power Corporation (CGN)'s clean energy base in northern Laos.Can China and Laos collaborate on a solar power project?

In what is the first large-scale solar photovoltaic project in Laos, CGN will collaborate with more than 70 Chinese and Laotian enterprises to establish a benchmark for electricity cooperation under the Lancang-Mekong Cooperation framework. The clean energy base is a vital power source supporting China-Laos power interconnection.

How many power plants are there in Laos?

There are currently 42 operational power plants in Laos. The country plans to achieve an installed capacity of 14,000MW by 2020, and to install 54 more electricity transmission lines and build another 16 substations to support this growth.

How will China-Laos energy transition work?

The clean energy produced will be transmitted to Yunnan province in China via the China-Laos 500kV grid, supporting Yunnan's energy transition and power supply security. Laos is currently at a critical stage of its energy transition.

How does CGN contribute to Laos' economic development?

In addition to contributing to Laos' economic development, CGN is committed to sharing the benefits with local communities. CGN has implemented initiatives such as vocational training, educational support, community building, medical assistance, and agricultural aid to address urgent local needs and improve living standards.
